Clark County High Capacity Transit study seeks input from all community members

Clark County, WA – The Clark County High Capacity Transit (HCT) System Study invites all members of the public to a study Sounding Board meeting on Wednesday, June 13th at 6:00 p.m. in the Clark County Elections Building. The study team has received valuable comments from community members and has successfully narrowed the list of travel corridors and transit technologies to carry forward for further study.

Sounding Board attendees will receive an update on study progress and have an opportunity to share their opinions on the evaluation criteria the study team will use for the corridors and alignment analysis. This input will assist the team in matching the recommended travel corridors with the most effective transit technologies to design a successful HCT system for Clark County.

The Clark County High Capacity Transit System Study is evaluating various HCT transit technologies and travel corridors in Clark County to determine which will best meet the future transit needs of county residents.
