### **Task Force of Clark County High Capacity Transit Study meets Monday**

**Clark County, WA** – The Task Force of the Clark County High Capacity Transit (HCT) System Study meets again on Monday, February 18, at 6:00 p.m. at the Clark County Public Service Center, 1300 Franklin St., Vancouver, WA. Attendees will meet in the 6th Floor Training Room. The Task Force will compare the five corridors under consideration for high capacity transit in Clark County using detailed corridor information to evaluate which corridors they advise for further study. The corridors currently being reviewed include I-5/Highway 99, I-205, SR-14, SR-500 and Chelatchie Prairie. All members of the public are welcome to attend the meeting.

The Task Force is a group of fourteen representatives from a range of community interests, including local colleges, businesses, neighborhood associations, environmental groups, health and safety organizations, building trade associations, education, transit users, and youth and leadership councils. The Clark County HCT System Study is evaluating various HCT transit technologies and travel corridors in Clark County to determine which will best meet the future transit needs of county residents.
