SUBJECT: **TIB FY2019 Grant Awards**

AT A GLANCE - DISCUSSION

Seven transportation improvement projects in SW Washington will receive approximately \$1.4 million in grants through the Transportation Improvement Board.

INTRODUCTION

The Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) distributes grant funding to cities and counties for priority local transportation improvements. Funds come from a portion of the statewide gas tax.

Attached for your information is a list of projects selected for FY 2019 Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) grants within the RTPO region (Clark, Skamania, and Klickitat Counties). The TIB Board selected projects at their November 17, 2017 meeting. A total of seven projects within our region were selected for TIB funding, totaling approximately \$1.4 million in grant funding.

Urban Sidewalk Program

- **Highway 99 – Kline Sidewalk, NE 122nd St. to 129th St.** (Clark County): Construct Sidewalk along east side of Highway 99. *Total project cost of \$622,000, with a TIB grant award of \$150,000.*
- **Fourth Plain Boulevard, Wintler Dr. to Caples Av.** (Vancouver): *Reconstruct sidewalk along Fourth Plain. Total project cost of \$268,780, with a TIB grant award of \$208,780.*

Small City Arterial Program

- **SE 4th Avenue, E Jewett Blvd to SE Wyers St** (White Salmon): This project will reconstruct a major collector. *Total project cost of \$327,409, with a TIB grant award of \$311,308.*
- **Humboldt, Cedar and Cherry Streets: Maple St to Cedar and Humboldt to SR 14.** (Bingen): This project will reconstruct several major collector segments. *Total project cost of \$635,200, with a TIB grant award of \$606,740.*

Small City Sidewalk Program

- **S Columbus Avenue ADA Ramps, Broadway Av. to Simcoe Dr.** (Goldendale): *Total project cost of \$146,856, with a TIB grant award of \$85,000.*

Small City Preservation Program

- **FY 2019 Seal Coat Project** (North Bonneville): This project will allow the city to restore road surfaces at multiple locations. *Total project cost of \$45,247, with a TIB grant award of \$45,247.*
- **FY 2019 Seal Coat Project** (White Salmon): This project will restore road surfaces at multiple locations. *Total project cost of \$39,546, with a TIB grant award of \$37,569.*
