SUBJECT: **TIB FY2020 Grant Awards**

AT A GLANCE - DISCUSSION

Four transportation improvement projects in SW Washington will receive approximately \$3.45 million in grants through the Transportation Improvement Board.

INTRODUCTION

The Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) distributes grant funding to cities and counties for priority local transportation improvements. Funds come from a portion of the statewide gas tax.

Attached for your information is a list of projects selected for FY 2020 Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) grants within the RTPO region (Clark, Skamania, and Klickitat Counties). The TIB Board selected projects at their November 16, 2018 meeting. A total of four projects within our region were selected for TIB funding, totaling approximately \$3.45 million in grant funding.

Urban Arterial Program

- **SE 1st Street, SE 164th Av. to SE 177th Av.** (City of Vancouver): Reconstruct to 3 lane urban standard section with sidewalks and bicycle lanes. Total project cost of \$14,056,000, with a TIB grant award of \$3,000,000. *RTC has provided \$3,457,600 in federal STBG for this project.*

Small City Preservation Program

- **FY 2020 Overlay Project** (Goldendale): This project will allow the city to restore road surface at multiple locations. Total project cost \$195,579, with a TIP grant award of \$176,021.
- **FY 2020 Seal Coat Project** (Stevenson): This project will allow the city to restore road surface at multiple locations. Total project cost \$42,963, with a TIP grant award of \$40,815.
- **FY 2020 Seal Coat Project** (White Salmon): This project will allow the city to restore road surface at multiple locations. Total project cost \$240,333, with a TIP grant award of \$228,316.
