

Regional Grant Allocation and 2019-2022 TIP Amendment

Final 2018 Federal Allocation

- ◆ State modified CMAQ formula in 2018
- ◆ 2018 Federal Allocations Up 6.7%
- ◆ Available funds:
 - ◆ \$1,000,000 CMAQ
 - ◆ \$500,000 STBG

Need for Policy

- ◆ 2009 RTC Board Policy/Not included in Guidebook
- ◆ Purpose of Policy
 - ◆ Fair distribution of funds
 - ◆ Distributes funds quickly for regional projects
 - ◆ Provides funding certainty to local projects
 - ◆ Completing a new grant process not practical

New Guidebook Policy

- ◆ **Policy 4.9 – Increase in available federal funds.** If additional regional federal funds become available during the year, funds can be allocated to projects based on the most recent regional project evaluation and ranking process.

(RTAC and RTC Board Action would be required)

TIP Amendment

Following 2018 evaluation prioritization process, the TIP amendment will include:

- ◆ Mill Plain BRT would have \$1 million switched from STBG to CMAQ
- ◆ NE 99th Street would receive \$1,450,000 in STBG Funding (Next Priority Project)

Regional Grant Allocation and 2019-2022 TIP Amendment

Adoption of Resolution 02-19-02 which includes adding policy for federal funding increases and amending the Transportation Improvement Program utilizing the policy.
