Description: Sidewalk, crosswalk, curb extension, overlook, waterfront trail connection, and amenities.

Rank: 1 of 7

TA Award: PE \$132,800
CN \$442,600

Total Cost: \$804,850



NE 68th Street Sidewalk

Clark County/City of Vancouver

Description: Continuous sidewalk on south side with four key crossings.

Rank: 2 of 7

TA Award: CN \$1,700,000

Total Cost: \$4,346,000



NE Hazel Dell Av. Sidewalk

Clark County

Description: Construct sidewalk, curb ramps, bike lanes, and relocate mid-block pedestrian crossing.

Rank: 3 of 7

TA Award: PE \$79,600
(PE Only)

Total Cost: \$903,000
