

## Project Description

This project completed the next section of the Evergreen Highway Trail, which is part of the regional trail system. It connected to the existing trail terminus at Ellsworth Road and extended the trail west toward Weber Arboretum. The portion that was built with the first contract was from SE Ellsworth to SE 100<sup>th</sup> Court and the next section from SE 100<sup>th</sup> Court to Weber Arboretum is in the design phase.
