SUBJECT: **TIB 2019 Grant Awards**

AT A GLANCE - DISCUSSION

Six transportation improvement projects in SW Washington will receive approximately \$6.76 million in grants through the Transportation Improvement Board.

INTRODUCTION

The Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) distributes grant funding to cities and counties for priority local transportation improvements. Funds come from a portion of the statewide gas tax.

Attached for your information is a list of projects selected for grant funding in 2019 by the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) within the RTPO region (Clark, Skamania, and Klickitat Counties). The TIB Board selected projects at their November 22, 2019 meeting.

Urban Arterial Program

- **NE Everett Street (SR-500)/NW Lake Rd. Roundabout.** (City of Camas): Construction of a roundabout. Total project cost of \$7,452,000, with a TIB grant award of \$3,300,000.
- **SE 1st Street, SE 177th Av. to SE 192nd Av.** (City of Vancouver): Reconstruct to 3 lane urban standard section with sidewalks and bicycle lanes. Total project cost of \$12,900,000, with a TIB grant award of \$2,000,000. *RTC has provided \$4,457,600 in federal STBG funds for this corridor improvement.*

Sidewalk Program

- **NE Hazel Dell Avenue, NE 99th St. to NE 117th Av.** (Clark County): Sidewalk infill and repair, ADA ramps, and relocate crossing. Total project cost of \$864,000, with a TIB grant award of \$300,000. *RTC has provided \$79,600 in federal TA funds for this project.*
- **Devine, Mill Plain Blvd to E. 18th St.** (City of Vancouver): Sidewalk and crossing improvements. Total project cost \$400,000, with a TIB grant award of \$400,000.

Small City Arterial Program

- **NW Garfield Av., SR-141 to NW Washington St.** (City of White Salmon): This project will improve to urban standard. Total project cost \$292,081 with a TIP grant award of \$262,873.

Small City Preservation Program

- **FY 2021 Overlay Project** (City of Ridgefield): This project will allow the city to restore road surface at multiple locations. Total project cost \$626,031 with a TIP grant award of \$500,000.
