Project Description

The project built a bridge over Whipple Creek, completely reconstructed a rural, two-lane section of NE 10th Avenue to a two-lane major collector with center turn lane (C-2cb) standard, and adding continuous bicycle lanes and sidewalks.

- Constructed a bridge over Whipple Creek, completing connection between NE 139th Street and NE 179th Street.
- Improved traffic flow and level of service by widening this section of NE 10th Avenue to a two-lane major collector standard with continuous center turn lane.
- Improved pedestrian and bicyclist safety by adding continuous sidewalks and bike lanes.
- Improved sight distance by removing or relocating clear-zone hazards and obstructions.
- Sanitary sewer lines were added and waterlines were improved.
